## TOWN OF PERTH ORDINANCE MOTOR VEHICLE DUMPING

After a public hearing duly held on April 29, 1958, the Town Board of the Town of Perth, Fulton County, does hereby ordain and enact as follows:

Dumping, spreading, placing and/or causing the dumping, spreading, or placing of damaged or broken motor vehicles, or parts thereof, upon any lands within the Town of Perth by any person, firm, partnership, or corporation is hereby prohibited.

A violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute an offense, and upon conviction thereof, the offending party or parties shall be liable to a fine of not to exceed \$100.00, or to imprisonment in the county jail for not to exceed five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance upon seperate days shall constitute separate offenses.

This ordinance shall not apply to the placing of the personal motor vehicle or parts thereof, by any person, firm, partnership or corporation, upon lands owned or hired by such person, firm, partnership, or corporation.

Personal motor vehicle as used herein shall mean a motor

vehicle used by the person, firm, partnership, or corporation in whose name it is registered, or by whom it is owned, the personal and/or business purposes and not primarily retained for the purpose of sale, either in whole or in part.

Any person, firm, partnership, or corporation, engaged on March 1, 1958, in the business of dumping, spreading, placing, and/or causing the dumping, spreading, or placing of damaged or broken motor vehicles, or parts thereof, upon lands within the town of Perth, shall not be deemed to be in violation of this ordinance prior to November 7th, 1958.

This ordinance shall take effect May 7th, 1958.
